

X-RAY EXAMINATION REPORT

FINDINGS:

Cervical Spine

The cervical spine films are unremarkable and show no signs of structural abnormality. All vertebral body heights and density are within normal limits. There is a loss of the normal cervical curve. There is anterior head carriage, sectional towering to the left, head tilt to the left, and a high right shoulder. The APOM radiograph shows no indication of fracture. There is a reduction of disc height at C6/7 and C7/T1. There is a Grade 1 anterolisthesis at C5/6 and C6/7, accentuated in extension. There is mild anterior marginal osteophyte formation at C6 and mild posterior marginal osteophyte formation at C6 and C7.

Thoracic Spine

The thoracic spine films are unremarkable and show no signs of structural abnormality. All vertebral body heights and density are within normal limits. All intervertebral disc spaces are well preserved. Levodextroscoliosis with apex at T7 is noted. Marginal osteophytosis is noted.

Lumbar Spine

The lumbar spine films are unremarkable and show no signs of structural abnormality. All vertebral heights and density are within normal limits. There is a reduction of the normal lumbar curve. Pelvic unleveling to the left and sectional towering to the left are noted. There is a reduction of disc height at L4/5 and L5/S1. There is a Grade 1 retrolisthesis at L5/S1. There is moderate anterior marginal osteophyte formation at L4 and L5 and moderate posterior marginal osteophyte formation at L5. Neuroforaminal encroachment is noted at L5/S1. The hip joints are well maintained and are showing no signs of degenerative change or pathology. Post-operative hardware is present: Anterior fusion present at L4/5..

Left Shoulder

Radiographical evaluation of the left shoulder reveals AC joint degenerative change and mild glenohumeral joint space narrowing. Remaining bony alignment, bone density, and standard joint space integrity are within normal baseline thresholds.

IMPRESSION:

1. C5/6 and C6/7: Grade 1 anterolisthesis
2. Post-surgical hardware, lumbar spine
3. L5/S1: Grade 1 retrolisthesis
